It is one of the common names of a plant. It is also called yezgo. Honeydog, Jambu, Lesser Elderberry or Biezgo. Its scientific name Sambucus ebulus and belongs to the family Adoxaceae.

zimendu

It can mean in Basque language foundation or also foundation, base, pillar.

zoro

It is a word of the Basque language that means insane, crazy (a).

zubizarreta

Zubizarreta in Basque language means old bridge. It is also of a great Spanish goalkeeper, Andoni Zubizarreta called Basque surname.

zuhatz

It is a word that in the Basque language means trees.

zut

It is a word of the Basque language that means above, on top, top.
