Stewart (41 1951; Faygate, Horsham Sussex. It was drummer of the English band Genesis. He had been invited for the post of battery by Peter Gabriel, who was going to the same school as Stewart in 1967. Was then Genesis was guided by Jonathan King, one young slightly larger than they themselves had recorded a hit called "Everyone ' s gone to the moon ". King made the times of mentor, manager, and producer. Even it was that put them the final name to the band. The group composed a few songs that were not to the liking of King until Peter and Tony with a style more akin to the Bee Gees wrote Silent Sun, who encouraged King to put them in a recording studio to record the first single from Genesis in February of 1968. La training that would record the first single would be composed by Peter Gabriel Tony Banks, Anthony Phillips, Mike Rutherford, and Stewart's own.
