Climbing bird, about 12 cm in length from the tip of the beak to the tip of the tail and 20 of magnitude, with black feathers spotted in white, less the lower part of the start of the queue, which is grey in colour, and the upper part of the loin, which is reddish. It nests on trees and feeds on insects that live in them. Botijo (vessel for regrescar water). Grain or seed of some fruits and vegetables. ζ
