Bivalve molluscs called Europe " pinnae macras ". Its name derives from the hull of the Roman soldiers penna. The shells of the callus of axe have aspect trigonal, Cuneiform and are very thin.

callo de hacha

Edible adductor muscle of bivalve molluscs in the family Pinnidae, mainly species *Atrina maura*, tuberculous *Atrina*, *Atrina rigida* and rough *Pinna*, which are known in a colloquial manner as axes for its characteristic shape and large size.
