A common doubt for spanish speakers, confusion between "but, although" and "more, plus" because of the diacritic accent.

In Colombia, a "ñoco" is either a person who is lacking one or more fingers (or a whole hand), or the remaining flesh and bones of those fingers.

puto

In some parts of Colombia, it is used to refer to a man who is seen as a "fucking" something, a bastard, an asshole or an idiot; a "desgraciado" or a "maldito".
