acci¿n de la ca¿a

Cane action: 41 coast fishing; Range of weight of the plumb line and other accessories for bass line that is capable of supporting the cane during the launched process. It is usually expressed in grams or ounces.

aguja

Needle: (Fishing in Costa) Metallic utensil shaped hollow wire used for thread gusanas, muergos, sardines do place the hook into the hole in the wire and passes the bait by the up to well cover the hook.?

ahorcada

Ahorcada: (Fishing in Costa) It is named at the helm whose line of the reel is so tense that it leaves extremely arched cane stem.

aparejo

Rigging: (Fishing in Costa) It is named to set fishing lines, swivels, Plumb and hook which form the line low. Also is a form of manual fishing without a rod or reel used in docks or boat.

bajo de l¿nea

Line: (Fishing in Costa) Fishing gear is formed by a line which attaches a run plumb line or terminal position, emerillones, carabiners of union, pearls, and with hooks smaller size line.

barruntar

Barruntar: (Fishing in costa) Suspect that it is going to cause a change of time or the circumstances of the sea.

bichero

Hook: (Fishing in Costa) Stick of wood or aluminum that incorporates a large size hook aimed at nailing large fish and assist in his capture.

bolo

Bolo: (Fishing in Costa) Bank, camp or school of fish. Very bad fishing day.

brazolada

Branch line: (Fishing in Costa) Each lines equipped with hooks attached to the mother line and aimed to fish.

cañero

Grower: (Fishing in Costa) Metal pan fitted with two rings or brackets round, joined by a rod of tetracero that is nailed or placed in any hole ø tile of the springs, union that serves to hold upright the cane after his released waiting for that great dive.

capacho

Capacho: (Fishing in Costa) Basket or basket of Esparto grass to bring utensils and catches.

cascabel

Rattlesnake: (Fishing in Costa) Small metal sphere provided inside of a piece of metal and a clip that attaches to the pointer of the cane and notifies the fisherman when a fish bites.

casting

Casting: (Fishing in Costa) Name given to the competition launched par excellence.

ca¿ero

Beach grower: (Fishing in Costa) Like the previous one, is a steel or aluminum-metallic utensil in do V do, with a low, round bottom bracket, and other open top to support cane after released, which is stuck in the sand of the beach and serves to keep the cane stand waiting for the fish bite.??

ca¿o

Cano: (Fishing in Costa) Each channel which connects the sea with the marshes.

cámbaro

Cambaro: (Fishing in Costa) Name that is given to a species of crustaceans (in some areas 41 crabs; greenish and large front claws. They are highly valued as food and to use bait, why are most at certain times of the year. They are crab, spider crab and Masera type.

chambel

Chambel: (Fishing in Costa) Section thread between 1 and 2 meters in length in which, in one of its ends is placed or empatilla the hook where we will place the bait, to fish with cane.

cimera

cimera: (Fishing in Costa) Upper end of the cane. Stem

cola de rata

Rat tail: (Fishing in Costa) Thread from 10 to 15 metres with different thicknesses ranging from less to more, and used as a bridge between the line of work of the spool and the bass line.

cordel

String: (Fishing in Costa) Wire of twisted multifilament thicker than the usual lines, usually used for fishing from boat. Gusana long size that usually embody chopped into several pieces.

currican

Trolling: (Fishing in Costa) Technique of fishing from boat in which a sample provided with hooks or jiggers is towing. From Earth so we fish in the form of spinning.

drop

Drop: (Fishing in Costa) The distance that it gives to the line including the lead, rigging and cane pointer, prior to performing the lance, its length may vary depending on taste of the fisherman or the lance mode.

jig

Jig: (Fishing in Costa) Decoy, metal sample used in the jigging fishing.

jigging

Jigging: (Fishing in Costa) Mode of fishing from boat, characterized by the use of Plumb or metal samples destined for the fishing of large predators.

knot

Knot: (Fishing in Costa) Knot, nautical measure to designate the speed of the wind or a boat. Any kind of fisherman's knot.

minnow

Minnow: Shows with small fish and attractive flashes of the size of a boqueron.

popper

Popper: (Fishing in Costa) Lure characterized by breaks and sounds emitted from slipping on the water.

reel

Reel: (Fishing in Costa) Spool, is known mainly as well to reel multiplier or rotary.

salabre

Cistern: (Fishing in Costa) Pan than provided at one end of a handle, and the other on a small network, use to remove the fish from the water. Also called Redeño or Bogagrip.

spinning

Spinning: (Fishing in Costa) Fishing pattern of light released in which all sorts of samples and artificial lures are used primarily.

starlight

Starlight: (Fishing in COsta) Light device that attached to the pointer of the cane helps us display bites during the night fishing.

surfcasting

Surfcasting: (Fishing in Costa) Mode of employing equipped with fixed or rotating reels rods and fishing that is launching on the waves from the beach.

tresmallo

Tresmallo: (Fishing in Costa) In a set of three static networks that are placed at sunset and remain fixed during the night floating half water in places of movement of fish. Is an extremely effective method of which very few fish are escaping, and therefore the greatest enemy of the angler is very regulated in all the costa. ¿Es. do?

tr¿pode

Tripod: (Fishing in Costa) Equipped with three points of support support to maintain the cane erect during the fishing action. She is mainly used in breakwaters and areas with too hard surface to use picas, skewers or baitboats. It also serves to take the container where we took the bait hook.

vadeador

Vadeador: (Fishing in Costa) Dress boots rubber or boots and pants, waterproof bib, which serves to introduce us in the water and bring los lances or pick up better when brings piece composed. There are several models depending on the weather or surface.

vinilo

Vinyl: (Fishing in Costa) Artificial lure made of such material, whose texture and colors reminiscent of the meat and body baits and fish. Some of these lures are flavouring substances added to enhance its power of attraction.

zahorra

Gravel: (Fishing in Costa) Sandy yellow used for the gusanas preservative.

zapatilla

Shoe // Zapatillona: (Fishing in Costa) Golden (Sparus Aurata) small or medium-sized.
