vicera

In the town of Borobia (Soria) bordering on Aragon, the vicera was also related to the community grazing of mountain cows, resulting also the same procedure of collecting cows, such as goats, in the morning and taking them to the village in the afternoon, in which each animal went only to the owner's house; The shepherd brought in his backpack the kid if he had given birth to the goat. There were two different viceras, each with its shepherd goatherd or cowboy. The call was made with a bagpipe from the top of the hill of the castle, in the center of the town, first the cowboy and then the goatherd always. There was another equal grazing for the mules of the town for when they did not have to work, which in this case is called "gluttony"
