aquelarre

Coven is derived from the Basque or euzkera and decomposes into: "Aker " = macho cabrio and "Larre " = field. Traduciendose as "Place of the macho cabrio " and later at "Place or reunion of Bruges ".

chacoli

Chacoli is derived from the Basque or Txakoli euzkera and means "Came from the 34 caserio;. It is a white wine produced from grapes green.

chiripa

chiripa means " 34 coincidence; -it comes from the Basque language (Basque) and written " txiripa " and pronounced chiripa

cucha

Kucha means "Box " and comes from the language Euskara (Basque). Kutxa is written and pronounced Doghouse. It is associated to the House or the dog box

pilpil

Pilpil comes from the Basque language (Basque) and means "throb or borbotar default in America is used for "FRY" .as eg. "prawns with pilpil"

taita
