Agilado; go to step fast without stopping is to converse with anyone

bigote

Mustache; Located on the top of the upper lip of the human hair. Usually in men, representing for them synonymous with machismo

cataplum

Sound emitted by a body or object to make impact with the water from a considerable height

co

Co is incorrectly written, and should be written as "Cone" being its meaning:
Cone; profane word issued as kind of cry expressed to hit or hurt themselves with an object

estar hastiada

being tired is incorrectly written and it should be written as "be jaded ()" being its meaning:
Be weary; that gives you the same one thing or another, doesn't care to live or die, it may be caused by a disease or disappointment

que es majunche

What majunche is incorrectly written and should be written as "Majunche" as meaning:
They are the fruits that are not formed with its normal growth, so are deformed in their physical appearance, often wrinkled, small and negritos

sucuperteristica

Sucuperteristica: Adjective used when interrogating a person by their situation, be it economic or health.

tabiquillo

Tabiquillo: is a small building of brick, block, stone cartor, wood or any other material where you can place well is a window, wall, table or corner in order to take advantage of these spaces to make them look neat and aesthetic whether in the areas of work and homes
