**caíz**

In some areas of Aragon, as equivalent to 179,36 litres capacity for aggregates and measured equivalent to 5.714,24 m<sup>2</sup> surface. A cahiz equals 8 bushels.

**hanega**

In some areas of Aragon, the bushel is equal 22,42 litres as a measure of capacity of aggregates and 714,28 m<sup>2</sup> as a surface. It is the amount of wheat that was used for the surface of the same name. It is equivalent to 1/8 of Chaiz and 12 almudes.
