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majagua

majagua is incorrectly written, and should be written as "MAJAGUA" being its meaning:
MAJAGUA: Stem of the PLATANOPor example, the trunk of the plant, which is called the stem, a raw material that will allow you to manufacture resistant cords can be removed.The stem is formed by a central yolk covered by leaves that surround it. Each leaf is a pod and can have 20 on each stem. They are the basis for the manufacture of rope. That rope is called majaguaSe used a lot within the rural sector to tie cakes, tamales, full. They used that name in Santa Marta, North coast of Colombia
